- 4.5.2.6. Audio-recording. A student may be authorized to make an audicording of what is said during class;
- 4.5.2.7. Laptop. A student may be authorized to have to use a laptop during class and/or or tests;
- 4.5.2.8. Captioned/subtitled videos A student may be authorized to have any videos that are used in or for class be captioned or subtitled;
- 4.5.2.9. Test reader. A student may be authorized to have someone to serve as a test reader read the tests to the student (usually provided in the Studentbild Services Testing Center);
- 4.5.2.10. Test scribe. A student may be authorized to have someone to serve as a test scribe to write the student's answers on a test (usually provided in the Student Disability Services Testing Center);
- 4.5.2.11. Breaks. A student may be authorized to have short, no more than a few minutes pe hour of class, breaks during class (e.g., to use the restroom or to consume food); and
- 4.5.2.12. Sign language interpreter. A student may be authorized to have a sign language interpreter to assist the stude **ntid** g class and/or on tests.
